
An overview of Safenames' Legal Services for the year.



In 2018 alone, Safenames Legal has covered over 30 different ccTLDs in through its legal services.

The .io ccTLD is assigned to the British Indian Ocean Territory, a small set of islands south of the Maldives. Its actual use, however, mirrors a gTLD as it has become surprisingly popular with start-up tech companies and video games. It is even 14th among ccTLDs for total sales in USD, above .us and .cn. In January, Safenames Legal recovered <williamhill.io> after a successful case in late 2017, our first ever conducted for a .io domain name.

Safenames Legal also oversaw the successful retrieval of <nvidia.ai> through arbitration. This was the first .ai retrieval for Safenames, and we have reason to believe it was, outright, the first ever. Safenames Legal's work led to the Registry choosing to comply with any decision rendered through the National Arbitration Forum. The .ai ccTLD is assigned to Anguilla, though its value as a TLD extends far beyond this Caribbean island.
